

Westmoreland Town Board
Audit Meeting
January 25, 2011

The Annual Audit meeting for the Westmoreland Town Board was called to order at 7:00 P.M., January 25, 2011 at the Westmoreland Town Hall, 100 Station Road, Westmoreland, NY, by Supervisor Gregory Sydoriw. Present were Councilperson Kenneth Eisnor, Charles Hebbard, David Husted and Hubert Pritchard. Also present was Linda Talma; Supervisor's Bookkeeper.

The Board audited the Supervisor's books and signed each report. Discussion was held on the elevated bills for the filtration plant. Pumping is down, but the electric bills have doubled over last year. The Bookkeeper reported that the sales tax was up almost \$40,000.00 over last year.

Discussion was held on the Highway Fund. Councilperson Pritchard would like to see time sheets with time started and ended for each shift worked. Also, Councilperson Husted feels the Highway Department is using too much sand.

The Board audited the Justice Court books, one questioned “bail poundage?”

All Board members signed the Justice Court books.

The Town Clerk presented the reports and vouchers for 2010.

32 A motion to amend the totals on the motions 29 and 30 to include the pre-paid as well as the un-paid vouchers was advanced by Councilperson Hebbard and seconded by Councilperson Husted. All Board members voted AYE and the Supervisor declared the motion carried.

A motion to sign the contract for the codification of the Town laws was advanced by Supervisor Sydoriw. There was no second. Councilperson Pritchard stated that he had

called the Association of Towns. They told him to contact municode.com. Councilperson Pritchard will call them.
